We will be supporting **Cardiac Risk in the Young (CRY)** and **Indian Ocean Disaster Relief (IODR)**.

CRY was founded in 1995 by Alison Cox to raise awareness of Sudden Death Syndrome (SDS) and Sudden Cardiac Death (SCD). There are 12 sudden deaths every week in the UK from undiagnosed heart conditions. CRY provides medical information on the causes of unexpected sudden cardiac death in the young. The charity campaigns for proactive screening of young people and carries out Mobile Screening and ECG Testing programmes in local communities, contributing to medical research. IODR is UK registered charity (founded by family members of CBRE London based Jay Singh) working to alleviate the suffering of disaster stricken communities in the Indian Ocean region. The charity is working towards this through the provision of sustainable education and training programmes that improve the capacity of local organisations and enhance the livelihoods of vulnerable children and young people. IODR aspires to see a world where all children have the opportunity to reach their full potential and undertakes 2 types of projects: immediate emergency relief following natural disasters and long-term managed/funded community projects.
